This funding will be used to

- Have 100% of students achieving on or above the National Minimum Standard for Reading.
- Have 95% students achieving on or above the National Minimum Standard in Grammar and Punctuation.
- Improve the Mean Scale Score (MSS) for Year 5 Grammar and Punctuation from 352 (below National Mean) to 400.
- Have 100% of students not on an ICP achieving a 'C' standard in English and Maths.

Our initiatives include

- Employing an additional 0.6 teacher to provide class support in all areas of learning.
- Implementing a Grammar and Punctuation program across the P-6 cohort.
- Professional Development for teachers to upskill in the teaching of Grammar and Punctuation.
- Providing Writing workshops for students to improve their Writing skills.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing extra teaching time to explicitly teach students Grammar and Punctuation.
- Implementing an effective internal monitoring and student data on Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation.
- Reviewing and revising Curriculum and Reporting Framework to emphasise quality teaching of critical content from the Australian Curriculum.
