- Ensure 100% of students are reading at age level.
- Ensure 66% of Year 3 and Year 5 students attain a B or above in English and Maths.
- Reduce the number of students on an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP) in 2021.
- Ensure 66% of Year 5 students are in Upper 2 Bands in all areas of NAPLAN, 50% of Year 3 students in Upper 2 Bands in Numeracy and Writing in NAPLAN with a significant improvement and growth in NCDD students.

Our initiatives include

Initiative	Evidence Base
Employing an additional 0.6 teacher to provide Explicit Instruction and Visible Learning to implement the Australian Curriculum from K-6.	Since employing a second teacher students A-E data has continued to improve. Intervention programs have seen 18 months growth in our ICP student for the past 2 years. Direct Instruction effect size 0.59 (Visible Learning for Literacy – Fisher, Frey & Hattie)
Implementing the SMART Spelling Program across the P-6 cohort. Professional Development for new teacher and teacher aide to learn about how to teach spelling using the SMART Spelling Program	Poor spelling in 2019 NAPLAN, current program was not working and students were not retaining and using their words in their writing. Shared beliefs and Understandings (Parameter 1.d – Teachers and Administrators need to be able to articulate what they do and why they teach the way they do – Putting faces on the Data - Sharratt & Fullan) Know-ability, Mobilize-ability and Sustain-Ability (Putting Faces on the Data - Sharratt & Fullan)
